## COVID SAFETY PLAN - RED

### ATTENDANCE

- School is open for ALL students, EVERY day.
- You must stay at home if you are sick, required to self-isolate or awaiting a negative COVID test result.
- Children with complex medical needs should seek advice from their health professional about whether it is safe to come to school.



### PUBLIC HEALTH MEASURES IN USE

- Good hand hygiene - including sanitising.
- Cough and sneeze etiquette
- Avoiding touching face
- Regular cleaning and disinfecting of surfaces
- Room ventilation (and "outside" classrooms)
- Contact tracing, vaccination and mask use.



### MASKS

- Children in Year 4\* and up MUST wear a mask (not bandanas or scarves) when indoors at school. This is a legislated requirement in all NZ schools - we appreciate your support.
- A mask will be provided for children who arrive without one and they will be required to wear it indoors at all times.
- All staff, parents and visitors will wear masks when onsite.

*\*NOTE: As we only have a small group of Year 4 students, in a class with mostly Year 3's masks are optional for Year 4's at this stage,*



### DISTANCE LEARNING

- Provided for children who:
  1. Have complex medical needs and are learning from home on the advice of their health professional.
  2. Are required to self-isolate (and are otherwise well.)
  3. Are awaiting a negative COVID test result.
- Provided in the event of an extreme staffing shortage.



### TRAVEL TO AND FROM SCHOOL

- Buses will operate as normal, at the normal times.
- Masks are required on the bus aged 12 and over - *THIS WILL SOON CHANGE TO INCLUDE ALL CHILDREN FROM YEAR 4.*
- Drop off and pick up from the **BOTTOM CARPARK.**
- Please do not linger - this creates congestion at busy times.
- Children to go straight to their classroom on arrival.



### SOCIAL DISTANCING

- Physical distancing between class groups of 1 m indoors and outdoors - playground/field rotation during breaks.
- Assemblies, performances, whole-school gatherings either outside or avoided - on a case-by-case basis.
- No unnecessary visitors onsite - please make appointments to speak to or see your child's teacher if necessary.
